

Suggestions to viewers who can't see cams.

Please know that tens of thousands of individuals with a wide array of devices and browsers ARE seeing the stream successfully. We have stats that tell us what devices and what browsers are being used. Most of our viewers watch on computers, but we have a lot of people also watching on many different types of mobile devices; tablets & phones. Most are on Windows - and I know people with Windows 7 and Windows 10 can see this just fine.

The problem might be a configuration you have on your own computer or device.

Be SURE that you try different browsers. Don't rely on just one. If you don't see it on one browser; try another. Then try a tablet, such as an iPad, or your phone, such as an iPhone.

Be SURE Ad Blocker is disabled on your computer. Some videos are blocked when this is activated.

Check to see if McAfee (an antivirus protection program) is blocking it. If McAfee is blocking it, just open McAfee web advisor and say that this is a trusted site.... McAfee is a virus protection program. The link below will offer suggestions to allow a particular site to be viewed. Be SURE your computer firewall did not block our URL, eagles.org.
